

#### Structure, area and population

The Municipality of Agia in its present form came from the combination of four municipalities ("Kallikratis" Law. 3852/2010):

- Agia (seat of the Municipality)
- Evrimenon
- Lakereias
- Melivoias

The Municipality consists of 22 communities. Its population, based on the 2011 census, is 11,633 inhabitants and the its total area is 668,26 km2







### Identity

The Municipality of Agia is a rural, semi-mountainous, costal and tourist area, with

- Presence since the prehistoric times
- Mild climate and microclimate
- Mild and diverse natural environment, with altitudes 5-960 m and ground inclination 30% -60%
- Fertile soil with dynamic tree and arable crops
- Easy and quick access to and from major urban centres
- Proximity to the main northern and southern road axis of the country.

The area of the municipality comprises the biggest part of Mount Kissavos, Mount Mavrovouni and 60 km of coastline.





70% of the area of the Municipality is a designated NATURA site or is characterized as forest of aesthetic value.







In Municipality one can come across traditional villages and tourist sites, which give the area a special "color".
















The area has had intense religious life since the Byzantine period, which is traceable in a large number of religious monuments, such as:
















The Agia collection of church relics (Saints Anthony Orthodox Church) and the Anatoli church museum

### Local Economy

The largest proportion of the workforce in the region is employed in agriculture and animal husbandry. Agricultural products manufacturing activity is at craftsmanship level, while the area is becoming a hub for agricultural products.

Moreover, tourism is a key pillar of economic activity in the region and has experienced dynamic growth in recent years.

### **Local Economy - Tourism**

The area is a major tourist destination that gradually transcends the geographical boundaries of the region, attracting tourists from Greece, the Balkans and Europe in general.

A significant number of organized activities of alternative mountain and sea tourism and events (sporting and cultural) takes place every year, with a view, inter alia, to promoting the area and helping its tourism development





### Local Economy - Tourism

- Tourist accommodation, mainly along the coastline,
- three organized camps,
- the municipal camp of Agia Paraskevi,
- the municipal refreshment / café at Velika,
- two small ports (with educational and sporting activities)
- the Polidendri recreation area and
- the "TEMPI", "CHRYSALLIS" and "SEA/ THALASSA" theatres,

are representative of tourist infrastructure in the area.
